

The Board of Trustees of the Beechwood Association met on March 23, 2010 at 7:00 at the home of Joyce and Phil Richardson.

Present were Phil Richardson, trustee, Roman Warmke, president, Brad Jokish, treasurer, and Joyce Richardson, secretary.

Others have noted route 50 dangers. Perhaps there will be an access road put in to get to Food World, Sunoco, and Fruth's.

Any other business? Brad has volunteered to test the lake. Will someone ask Linda if she is interested in selling or lending her boat?
